Canticle - A Song of Peace

Isaiah 2.3-5

- All* Spirit of God, teach us your ways,
that we may walk in the paths of peace.
- 1* Come, let us go up to the mountain of God,
to the house of the God of Jacob;
- 2* That God may teach us his ways,
and that we may walk in his paths.
- 3* For the law shall go out from Zion,
and the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.
- 4* God shall judge between the nations,
and shall mediate for many peoples.
- 5* They shall beat their swords into ploughshares,
and their spears into pruning hooks.
- 6* Nation shall not lift up sword against nation,
neither shall they learn war any more.
